3) The item was on the agenda of a prior meeting of the Board occurring not more than five calendar days prior to the date of this meeting, and at the prior meeting the item was continued to this meeting.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The attached short-term employment action is submitted in accordance with the Education Code and District policy. Education Code 45103 defines "short-term employee" as any person who is employed to perform a service for the district, upon the completion of which, the service required or similar services will not be extended or needed on a continuing basis. "Short-term employees", employed and paid for less than 75% of a school year, are not a part of a bargaining unit.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The Maintenance II/HVAC position requires certification and responsibilities that continue to increase. It has been agreed upon by the District and CSEA Gold Chain Chapter 660 that it is in our best interest to make these changes; however, CSEA will be meeting until, tomorrow, December 18, 2019 to ratify this agreement. If it isn't ratified on December 18, 2019, the change will not be made on January 1, 2020.
