<u>BACKGROUND:</u> AB 2449 provides that new and re-elected Board Member terms will begin on the second Friday in Decemner. Ed. Code Sections 35143 and 5017, which govern the scheduling of Annual Organizational meetings, provides that there be a 15-day window period to hold the Annual Organizational after the terms begin. This year, the 15-day window period for districts begins on Friday, December 11th and allows for the Board of Trustees to elect to hold the Annual Organizational meeting on December 14th or 15th.

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> Pursuant to Education Code Section 60119, the Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on or before the eighth week of school. Notice of the public hearing was posted in three public places within the District and stated the time, place and purpose for the hearing 10 days prior to the hearing.

The definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home to complete required homework assignments. It does not mean that the district must have two sets of textbooks for each student. The textbooks or instructional materials, or both, are aligned to the content standards.
