#### 3.1 2020-21 School Reopening Plan

<u>EXPLANATION</u>: Board will discuss options for the reopening of schools for the 2020-2021 school year. El Dorado County is not currently on the COVID Monitoring List of counties, which means it is possible for the District to reopen with face-to-face instruction; however, El Dorado County is trending toward being placed on the Monitoring List at about the same time as school is scheduled to reopen. Additionally, there are significant concerns regarding the El Dorado County Office Public Health's capacity for testing and contact tracing. This lack of capacity mirrors the experience at state and national levels; therefore, it is necessary that the Board consider these factors in deciding how to reopen schools for the 2020-2021 school year.
