Spatial arrangement of rooms can be more than just four walls. Discussed other opportunities such as interstitial spaces as teaching and learning opportunities i.e.. corridors, large break out spaces, outdoor learning opportunities. What does a Classroom look like? How does outside Partnerships enhance these teaching environments? How to ensure design supports and welcomes all students and provides a framework for cultural support and their learning success. Some spaces discussed:

 - ii. Green Schools
 - iii. Maker Spaces
 - iv. Media Labs
 - v. Teacher Collaboration Spaces (Whole "Educational Family" Support)
- b. Derek reminder, our goal is to support the district's Vision and Goals.
